Trainer for our “Renewable PtX Training”

The [International PtX-Hub Berlin \(PtX Hub\)](#) has made it one of its primary goals to set up a broad-based and effective Human Capacity Development (HCD) concept on renewable power-to-X. A **modular basic training on Renewable PtX** serves as the main component for the rapid implementation of the measure. The content of the basic training will be gradually extended and improved by “add-on modules” as well as by additional, innovative educational approaches for knowledge transfer and skill-building. In 2021, already numerous comprehensive three-day trainings have been carried out, including interactive transfer workshops in our partner countries but also in Germany, e.g. with the relevant federal ministries or agencies and civil society.

The aim of the training is to enable and inspire the participants, depending on their previous knowledge and qualifications, for the topic of Renewable PtX and to convey its fundamental importance for defossilisation in the national and global context. In addition to technical and economic basics, the training focuses in particular on the central sustainability dimensions, as well as essential allocation concepts and development policy aspects. The primary target groups are decision-makers and experts in the political institutions in the partner countries of IC: ministries, public authorities, regulatory authorities, etc.

Central to the success of the training is the close involvement of established, experienced and competent trainers in the relevant areas, such as renewable energies and/or green hydrogen or Renewable PtX, with expertise in energy technology and economics, so that the experience gained in the process can be effectively and efficiently incorporated and implemented in the training. Beyond the content-related and methodological-didactic focus, profound intercultural experience in IC and ideally in the GIZ project environment is of particular importance for the successful implementation of this HCD component.

Due to the high demand for the PtX trainings, the PtX Hub would like to quickly expand the team of trainers both in general and for regional focal points. To support the master trainer in Germany, the PtX Hub is therefore looking for suitable trainers who are committed to renewable PtX and who - in close coordination with the team - can support the implementation of the international trainings or carry them out independently, carry out the preparation and follow-up, including evaluation of the trainings together with the team, and actively support the development of existing and new, subject-specific add-on modules. In addition, the establishment of an international network for sharing learning and teaching experiences, including annual events, is planned.

To this end, the PtX Hub plans to hold an initial **train-of-trainers** training and networking event in Berlin at the **end of April 2022**.



Requirements profile for applicants

- High interest in Renewable PtX and correspondingly high motivation as a trainer to share the enthusiasm and knowledge in intercultural training groups, in order to create new experts who have a high level of expertise in the field of PtX
- Education: University degree (Diplom/Master/Promotion/Habilitation) in engineering and/or economics with a focus on energy, climate or similar.
- Language: English required, German, French, Spanish, Portuguese, or other relevant languages of international cooperation desirable
- General work experience: teaching experience in university or higher education or other training experience
- Specific work experience: professional incl. intercultural and life experience in the countries of international cooperation in relevant thematic areas such as energy, climate renewable PtX desirable
- IC experience: experience in relevant institutions of international cooperation desirable
- Experience in cooperation with potential target groups of the PtX training such as ministries, regulatory authorities etc. in relevant thematic areas desirable

Travel: Currently, trainings are primarily held virtually, optional business trips may occur upon agreement.
